



Violet Yates Scholarship

The Violet M. Yates Scholarship Fund was established by Mrs. Yates' family in celebration of her eightieth birthday, and her lifelong concern for the education of foreign-born women residing in our area.

Information for each applicant. Please read carefully before applying:

The Intensive American Language Center (IALC) at Washington State University is pleased to announce a scholarship for women living in Whitman, Latah, or Nez Perce County. The requirements for this scholarship are as follows:

- 1) The applicant must be a female who is a non-native speaker of English.
- 2) The applicant must live in Whitman, Latah, or Nez Perce County. The applicant must hold a degree from a secondary institution (high school or equivalent) in which English is not the language of instruction.
- 3) Priority will be given to applicants who demonstrate financial need and who are not recipients of any other form of governmental or private scholarship for the study of the English language.
- 4) The recipient must use the scholarship for tuition at the IALC for one of the two eight-week sessions following the award period. She will be placed in one of six levels of proficiency ranging from beginning to high advanced English instruction.
- 5) To apply for this scholarship, the applicant must submit a completed application form, a personal statement, two local letters of recommendation, and a financial statement. * All documentation (including documents sent by mail) must be received no later than Tuesday, December 1, 2009. *
- 6) No individual may receive this scholarship more than once.
